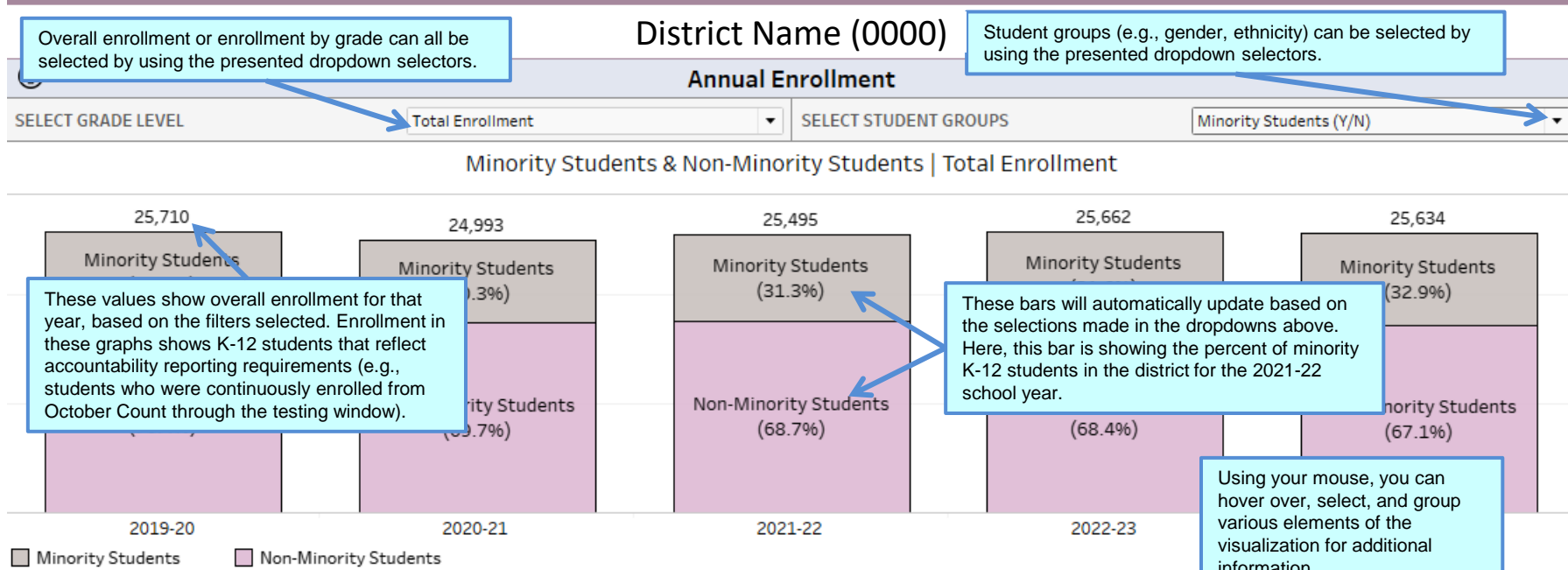




District and School Dashboard: Annotated Resources

- In order to support understanding of the District and School Dashboard tool, a series of annotated screenshots are provided in this document. Access to these visualizations are available through the following link: <http://www.cde.state.co.us/district-school-dashboard>.
- The District and School Dashboard tool has eight primary tabs, each reflecting either enrollment, assessment, accountability or postsecondary and workforce readiness data. This resource contains annotated versions of the following dashboards:
 - **Enrollment & Demographics (page 2):** a visual bar graph display of student enrollment data based on K-12 students who were continuously enrolled from October Count through the testing window. These results can be filtered based on user selected criteria (e.g., school and demographics). This display also indicates attendance and mobility data in separate graphs, sorted by year.
 - **Academic Achievement (page 3):** a visual bar graph that displays change in CMAS or ACCESS scale scores and participation rates over time. The display can be filtered by state, district, or school results. It allows for selections by grade level, by student group, and reference lines that show either state mean scale scores or state accountability ratings.
 - **Academic Growth (page 4):** a visual bar graph that displays change in CMAS or ACCESS growth percentiles and participation rates over time. The display can be filtered by state, district, or school results. It allows for selections by grade level, by student group, and reference lines that show either state median growth percentiles or state accountability ratings.
 - **On Track Growth (page 5):** visuals that display change in CMAS mean scale scores, growth percentiles, and percent On Track over time. The display can be filtered by state, district, or school results. It allows for selections by grade level, by student group, and reference lines.
 - **Postsecondary & Workforce Readiness (page 6):** visuals that display change in graduation rates, completion rates, dropout rates, and matriculation rates over time. The display can be filtered by state, district, or school results. It allows for selections by student group.
 - **Framework Results (page 7):** visuals that display change in performance framework ratings over time. The display can be filtered by state, district, or school results.
 - **Map Tools (page 8):** visuals that display a map of districts/schools in the state. Users can use the toggles available to find comparison districts by enrollment size and demographic characteristics (e.g., percent of students that are multilingual learners).

Assessment, reference line, grade level, and student group selections are available here.

Academic growth percentiles (MGPs) for the CMAS, Colorado PSAT/SAT, and ACCESS for ELLs are calculated for students who receive valid scores in at least two consecutive years. Median growth percentile (MGP) is the percentile of students who performed at the same level as the student in question. Results are not displayed in cases where the n-count is less than 20. Due to test administration impacts caused by the pandemic, 2020 and 2021 growth results are not available for all content areas and grade levels. A gray background denotes these results. Participation rate is shown in the label above each bar. A toggle on the right, has been added to allow users to select between cohort-referenced growth and baseline growth approaches to modeling academic growth : <https://www.cde.state.co.us/accountability/coloradogrowth>. Multilingual Learners describes students who are English Language Learners (ELL), Limited English Proficient (LEP), and Fluent English Proficient (FEP) - Monitor Year 1, Monitor Year 2, Exited Year 1, & Exited Year 2

Growth methodologies can be selected here. Cohort-referenced growth is used in performance frameworks. [Baseline growth](#) compares current performance against pre-pandemic expectations and is presented informationally.

Show/Hide Filters

This report header identifies the student groups reflected in the visualization.

The values reflected on the bars are median growth percentiles for the selected year, grade level, test subject, and student group.

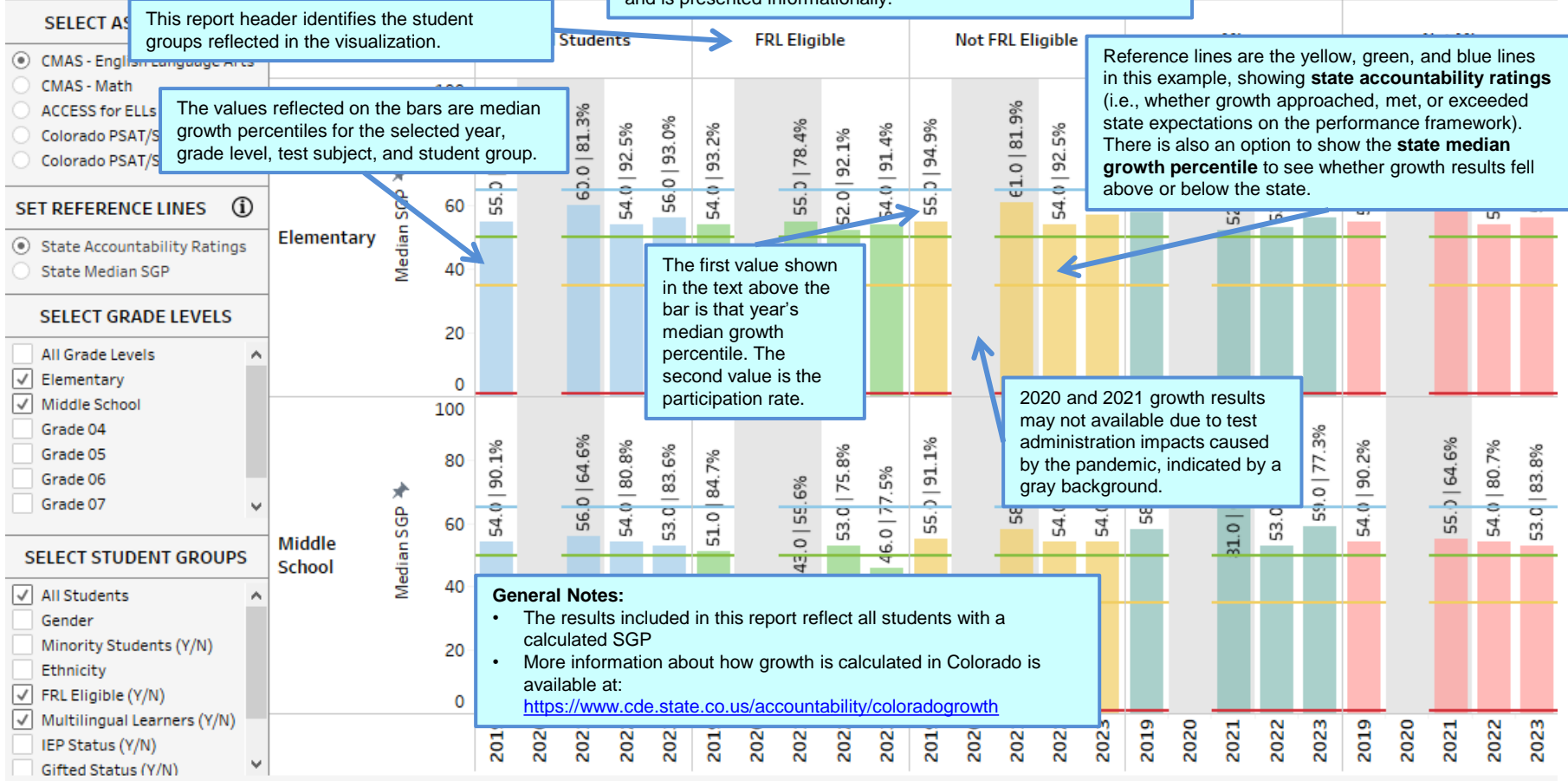
Reference lines are the yellow, green, and blue lines in this example, showing **state accountability ratings** (i.e., whether growth approached, met, or exceeded state expectations on the performance framework). There is also an option to show the **state median growth percentile** to see whether growth results fell above or below the state.

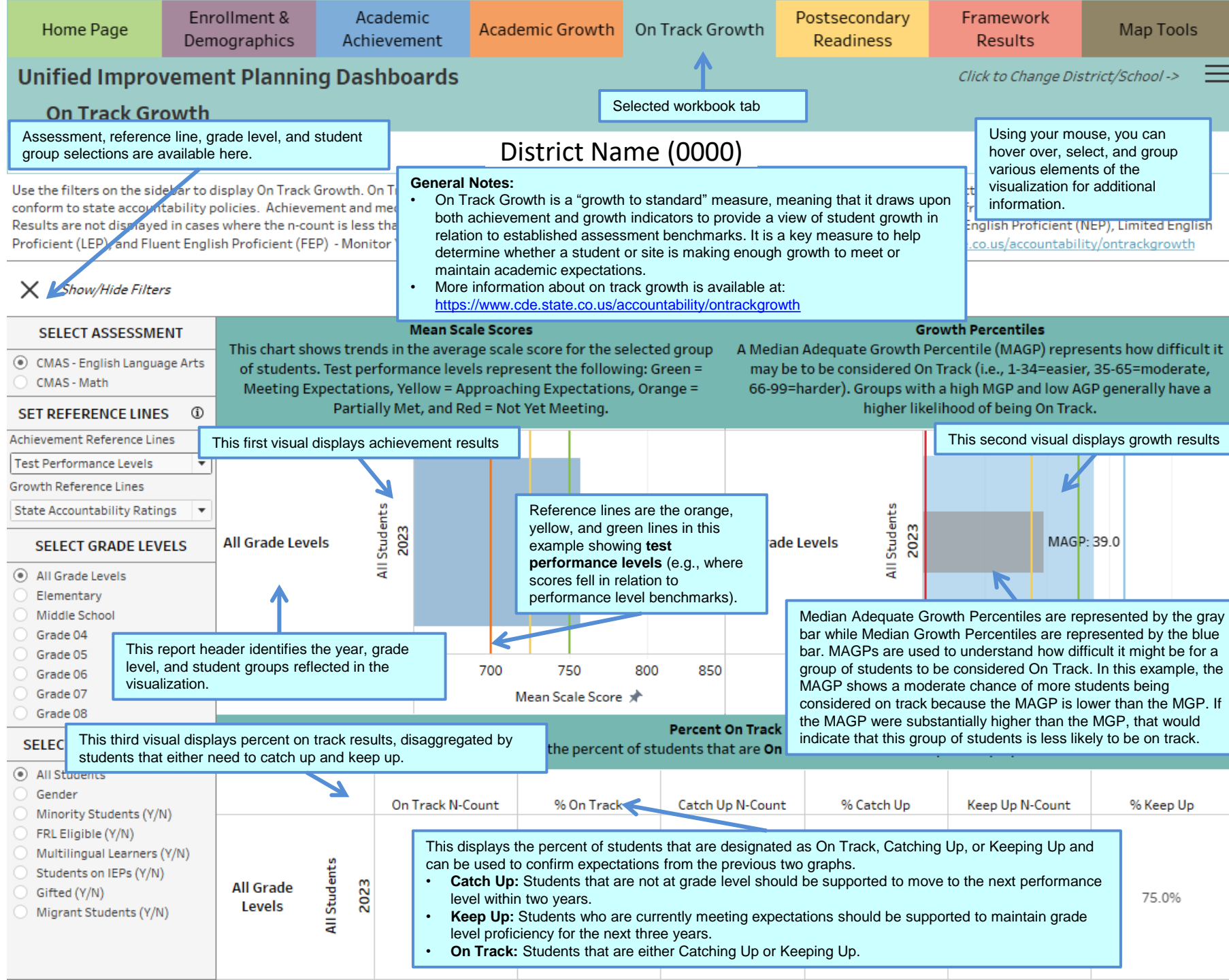
The first value shown in the text above the bar is that year's median growth percentile. The second value is the participation rate.

2020 and 2021 growth results may not be available due to test administration impacts caused by the pandemic, indicated by a gray background.

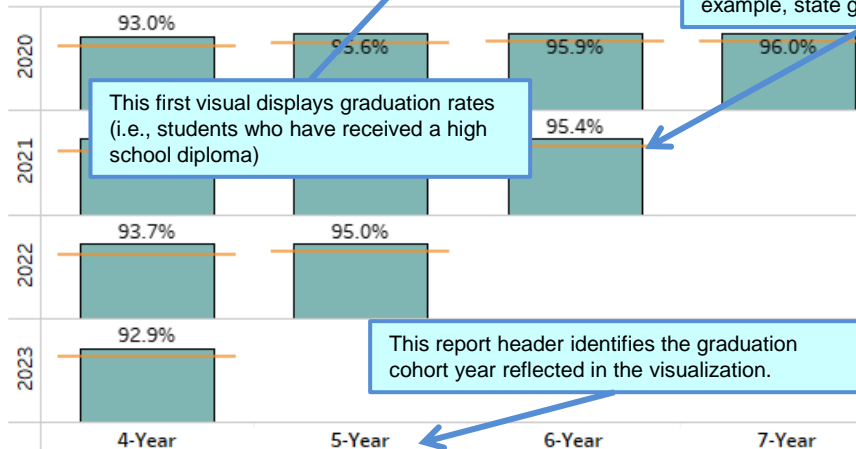

Colorado reports 4-year, 5-year, 6-year, and 7-year graduation rates, with the number of years that elapse between student entering ninth grade and



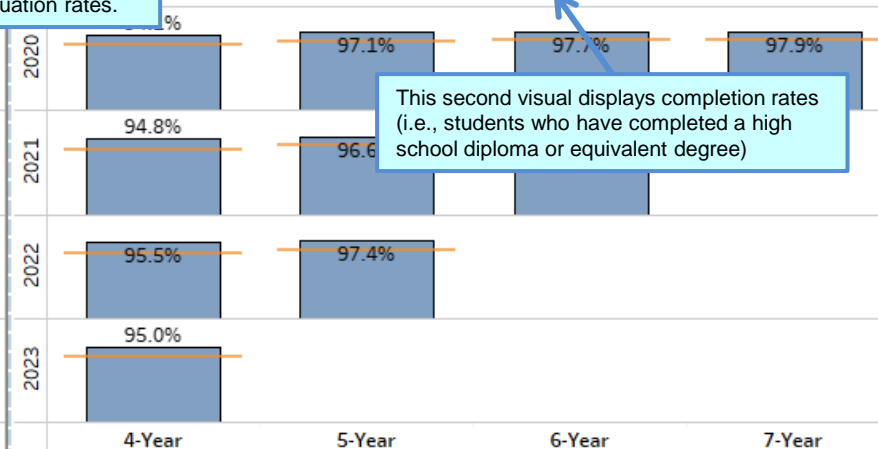
This first visual displays graduation rates (i.e., students who have received a high school diploma)

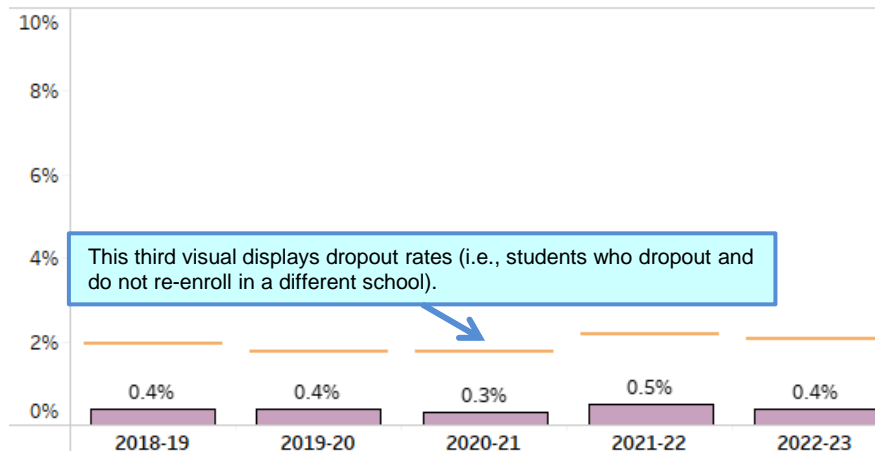

Dropout rates reflect the percentage of students included in the membership base who leave school during a single year and do not re-enroll in a different Colorado school.

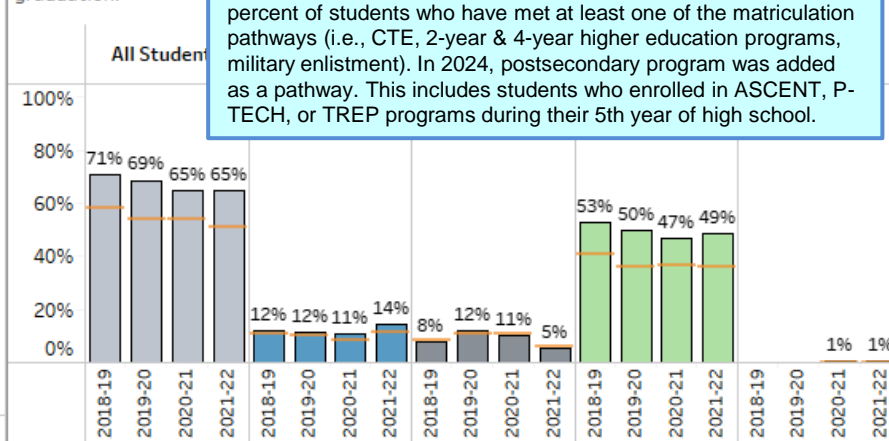


This third visual displays dropout rates (i.e., students who dropout and do not re-enroll in a different school).

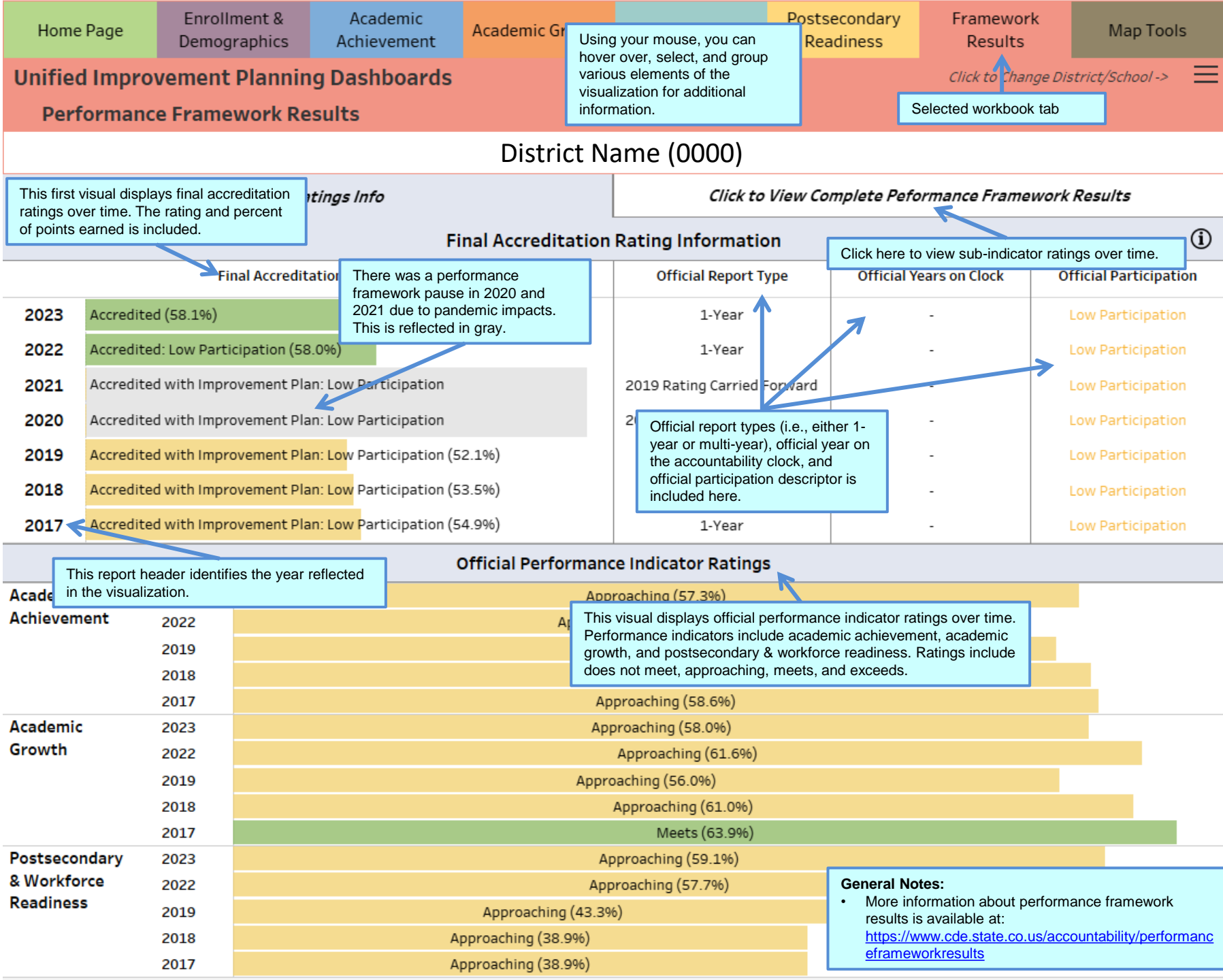

This reflects the percent of students who have met at least one of the matriculation pathways (i.e., CTE, 2-year & 4-year higher education programs, military enlistment). In 2024, postsecondary program was added as a pathway. This includes students who enrolled in ASCENT, P-TECH, or TREP programs during their 5th year of high school.

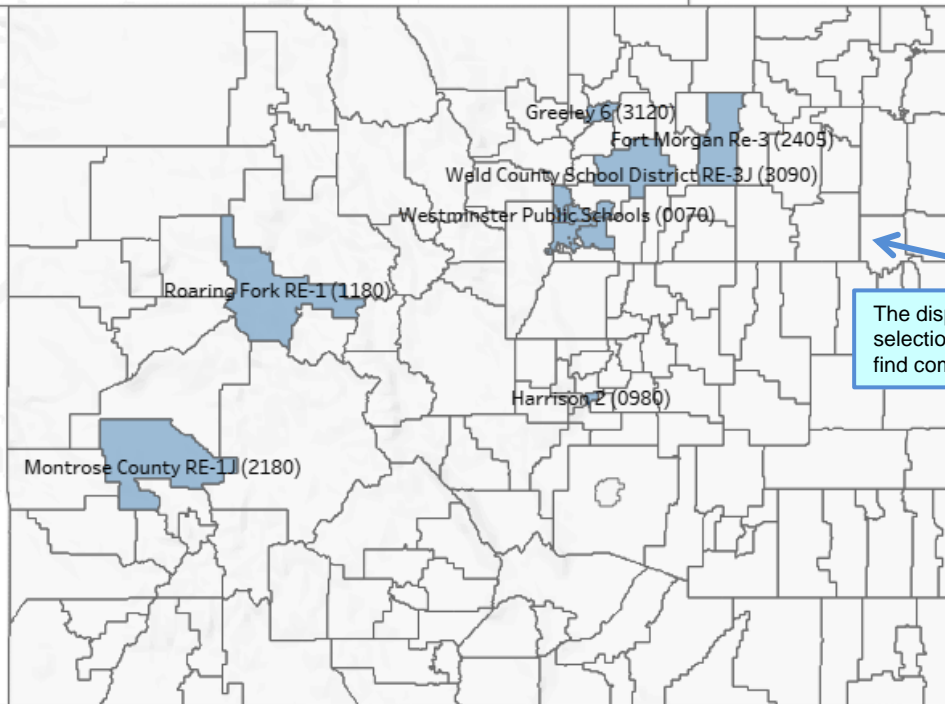
