CDE uploading student registration data into PearsonAccess ^{next} <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Districts will need to ensure that all student data is correct in Data Pipeline prior to December 18, 2015 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ CDE will set test format to online for all students for all subjects • From January 11-22, 2016, District will be able to make changes to student registration data in PearsonAccess^{next} through the UI or SR/PNP files <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Change test format to paper only for students that will need a paper-based version of the assessment ○ All paper-based orders will be derived from student registration data in PearsonAccess^{next} as of January 22, 2016

Computer-Based Testing

Paper-Based Testing	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students with oral presentation accommodation (i.e., human reader/signer, S/SS oral script) must be in a separate location and test session May have different test forms within a test session

Test Structure	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Terminology: ELA/Math Units = Sci/SS Sections <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each unit or section is a block of testing time for students Math units may consist of calculator and non-calculator sections 	
Opening Test Packaging (plastic wrap)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sealed packages may be opened no more than 4 days prior to testing 	
Make-up Testing	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can test units out of order only for make-up testing 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sections cannot be tested out of order

<p>5 weeks option (additional weeks for CBT ELA/L and math)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> March 28 - April 29, 2016 or March 21 - March 29, 2016 and April 4 - April 29, 2016 	
<p>6 weeks option (additional weeks for CBT ELA/L and math)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> March 14 - April 29, 2016 with one week of spring break between March 21 and April 11
