

DLM-KITE Site Readiness Checklist

Network Preparation

The KITE test engine utilizes a CDN for content distribution. All testing content will come from is <u>*.cete.us</u>. The whitelist settings can be found here: <u>http://kiteassessments.org/sites/default/files/KITE_f</u>

Local Caching Servers

A Local Caching Server (LCS) allows your computer to act as a dedicated network server, in this case for KITETM testing, which gives students and staff local access to KITE content. By using temporary storage, or a cache, the server is able to access data more quickly while reducing demand on the KITE servers. The LCS software will allow for **750 concurrent connections** at the minimum recommended configuration. **Note**: *Each* device that will be used for testing must be configured to use the LCS.
