

## PARCC Field Test – Assigning Read Aloud Accommodations (Text-to-Speech or Oral Script)

All students receiving a read-aloud accommodation/accessibility feature (Text-to-Speech) need to be in a separate test session, **not** a separate testing environment.

You will build the session as follows:

- Select Read Aloud by Text Examiner – No (no human reader) and
- Form Group Type – Text-to-Speech.
