

District Use of Speech-to-Text and Word Prediction District Checklist

Spring 2024 CMAS: Math, ELA, and Science*

District Assessment Coordinators (DACs) submit the following to CDE by February 15, 2024:

- Submit to CDE evidence that the vendor providing speech-to-text (STT) and/or word prediction technology service and the vendor providing the STT and/or word prediction application or plug-in in adherence to Colorado data privacy statutes and are approved for student use by our district.
- Submit to CDE specialized policies and procedures that assure students can access STT and/or word prediction tools only and do not have unrestricted internet access during assessment administration.
 - **Submit to CDE** detailed plan that describes procedures for restricting access to outside websites and browsers for STT and/or word prediction tools that require internet access.
- □ Submit to CDE specialized policies and procedures that guarantee electronic student answers follow all chain of custody requirements documented in the *Spring 2024 CMAS and CoAlt Procedures Manual* and are deleted after they are transcribed.
- Submit to CDE the number of students expected to access STT tools and the number of students expected to access word prediction on the Speech-to-Text and Word Prediction Security Agreement Supplement.
- **Submit to CDE** evidence of training on the use of STT and word prediction applications to SACs.

DACs and School Assessment Coordinators (SACs)

□ Maintain a master list at the district level of all students receiving the STT and word prediction accommodation on CMAS.

CMAS Test Administrators

- □ Train CMAS Test Administrators on specific procedures for the use of STT and word prediction, including:
 - Turning off translation features for the entirety of the CMAS assessment.
 - \circ $\,$ Turning off text-to-speech features during the ELA (including CSLA) assessment.
 - Securing test materials at all times.
 - Not explaining or reading passages, sources, or test items to students (except if administering the assessment with an auditory or signer script).
 - Adhering to standard unit testing times (except for students who have an extended time accommodation listed in their approved IEP, 504, or ML plan) and understanding that extra time may not be provided for lost work due to student or device error.
 - Not influencing student responses.
 - Not disclosing any test content that is viewed while providing the STT and word prediction accommodation or during the transcription process.
 - Ensuring electronic student responses follow all chain of custody requirements documented in the *Spring* 2024 CMAS and CoAlt Procedures Manual and ensure that responses are deleted after transcription.
 - Transcription procedures outlined in the Spring 2024 CMAS and CoAlt Procedures Manual (Section 6.1.6).
