### SEAL AND ENDORSEMENT OF BILITERACY

Thriving in a global society requires a global skill set. Being biliterate is one of the skills that indicates students are ready for the challenges of a global workplace. Moffat County School District (MCSD), with the support of the Colorado Department of Education (CDE), would like to recognize biliterate students by awarding a Seal of Biliteracy on their high school diplomas.

#### To earn the Seal of Biliteracy, MCSD proposes the following four requirements:

1. Students meet all MCSD graduation requirements.

#### AND

- 2. Students show literacy in English by accomplishing at least one of the following:
  - a. SAT score of 470 or higher on the section of Evidenced Based Reading and Writing
  - b. AP English Language exam score of 3 or higher
  - c. AP English Literature exam score of 3 or higher
  - d. IB English A, English Literature A, or English A1 score of 4 or higher

#### AND

- 3. Students show literacy in an additional language by accomplishing at least one of the following:
  - a. AP world language exam score of 3 or higher
  - b. AAPPL score of I-4 or higher
  - c. IB World Language score of 4 or higher
  - d. 4-Year high school course of study in a single World Language with a GPA of 3.0 or better in those courses

#### **AND**

- 4. Students participate in 10 hours of practical biliterate experience during their senior year where they use their additional language to communicate. Some examples:
  - a. Develop a resource to help families/students learn English.
  - b. Tutor students learning an additional language.
  - c. Be a Reading Buddy to an elementary student whose first language is the senior's additional language.
  - d. Volunteer at an establishment where the primary language is the student's additional language.

#### To earn the Endorsement of Biliteracy, students must:

Meet the four requirements above <u>and</u> have a GPA of at least 3.0 in MCSD's required English courses to meet the criteria for an <u>Endorsement in Biliteracy</u> awarded by CDE pursuant to Senate Bill 17-123.
