19 (40%) of the school's students scored below proficient on the Reading Comprehension Standard and 29 (60%) scored at or above proficient.a

29 students (60%) scored at or above proficient on the Fiction and Poetry subcontent area, 29 (60%) on Nonfiction, and 24 (50%) on Vocabulary.

The mean scale score on the test is 523 for the school, 553 for the district, and 568 for the state. On average, the school scored lower than the district and the state.

On average, students scored highest on Nonfiction (mean=545), next on Fiction and Poetry (mean=531) and lowest on Vocabulary (mean=518).

The standard deviation indicates the spread of the scores. The school's scores (SD=87) showed more variability than the district's (SD=71) or the state's (SD=75).

Students' scores showed the most variability on Nonfiction (SD=124) and the least on Vocabulary (SD=75).
