

SCHOOL GROWTH SUMMARY EXPLANATION

On school reports, this total is for all the grades in this school with growth. The district and state comparisons are for the same range of grades, NOT for all grades in the district or state. In this case, the district and state medians are for grades 9-10 only. That means you can do a fair comparison to see how this school stacks up against the district it's in as well as against the state as a whole.

These are the grades in this school at the Elementary, Middle, and High school level. In some cases the same school number will be associated with several reports. There will be a maximum of three grades in any one report.

Disaggregations only involve the grade span for this school included on this report, at school, district, and state levels. Any numbers that appear here are for kids that have growth percentiles and that were not excluded from the calculations using the (new in 2009) AYP-based criteria - those rules are in the wide text box at the bottom of this page.

This total is not just an average of the 9th and 10th grade percentages below, because there are probably different numbers of eligible students in each of these grades.

The kids eligible to Move Up in 2009 are a subset of the kids eligible to Keep Up, because they were Proficient (but not Advanced) in 2008.

Median growth percentiles of 50 or higher at the school or district level are highlighted in green, to illustrate groups growing at a higher level than the state as a whole.

All numbers are rounded for zero decimal places.

Kids are either eligible to Catch Up or to Keep Up in a given year, but they cannot be both. This is the percentage of all the Catch Up eligible kids in this district who actually caught up or were on track to Catch Up. The percentages will not add up to 100 any way you try, either by grade or by adding Catch Up and Keep Up numbers. See documents on CDE's website for how these are calculated.

Kids eligible to Catch Up in 2007 were Unsatisfactory or Partially Proficient in 2006, and they had a growth percentile in 2007.

Kids eligible to Keep Up in 2007 were Proficient or Advanced in 2006, and they had a growth percentile in 2007.

Kids eligible to Move Up in 2007 were Proficient in 2006, and they had a growth percentile in 2007.

These dashes mean that there were fewer than 20 non-excluded IEP kids, non-IEP kids, or both in this district. The cell in the table is only filled if both numbers can be displayed.

In order to receive a growth percentile score in a CSAP content area, a student needs to have valid scores in that content area from two consecutive years, following a normal grade progression.

Reporting Student Growth Scores Grouped at the School, District, and State Level

- **School Level:** Growth percentile scores are included in school summary calculations only for those students whose growth scores reflect two consecutive years continuously enrolled in the same school (or in the next school level up within the same district, such as from a middle school to a high school), and who were not expelled in the second of those two years.
- **District Level:** Growth percentile scores are included in district summary calculations only for those students whose growth scores reflect two consecutive years continuously enrolled in the same district.
- **State Level:** All growth percentile scores are included in calculations.
