School Districts and has held central office positions in Littleton and Aurora Public Schools. He has been a classroom teacher in traditional and alternative settings. curriculum developer, and university professor; and

Dr. Asp has served on a variety of state advisory boards and committees including: the Standards and Assessment Implementation Council, the Technical Advisory Committee for the Colorado Student Assessment Program, the Technical Advisory Group for Longitudinal Growth, the Governor's P20 Education Advisory Council and facilitated the Accountability Work Group.
