Dear Superintendents and BOCES directors,

Today, I am sharing the update below that we received from the Council of Chief State School Officers on Friday, June 13.

**From CCSSO: Update on FY 2025 Preliminary Allocations**

*The US Department of Education (ED) has been delayed in sending allocation calculations to states in accordance with the continuing resolution that Congress passed in March to fund the federal government through the end of fiscal year (FY) 2025 (Sept. 30). To date, ED has released the following preliminary FY 2025 estimates of state allocations to SEAs:*

- *Title I, Part A: Grants to Local Educational Agencies*
- *Title I, Part B: State Assessment Formula Grants*
- *Title I, Part D: Programs for Children and Youth Who Are Neglected, Delinquent, or At-Risk*
- *Title IV, Part A: Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grant*
- *Education for Homeless Children and Youth*

*ED has told CCSSO it is working on allocations for additional funding streams, and CCSSO anticipates those will be communicated soon.*

To date, at CDE, we **have** received preliminary allocation information for the 25-26 school year for the following:

- Title I-A: Improving Basic Programs Operated by Local Educational Agencies
- Title I, Part B: State Assessment Grants
- Title I, Part D – Prevention and Intervention Programs for Children and Youth Who Are Neglected, Delinquent, or At-Risk
- ESEA Title IV-A: Student Support and Academic Enrichment (SSAE)
- ESEA Title VII-B - McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Funds
- *Partial* Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title II – Adult Education and Family Literacy Act (AEFLA)
- Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS)’s Grants to States, and
- IDEA Part B State Grants: Individuals with Disabilities Education Act
