Dear Superintendents and BOCES directors,

Today, we saw a [news](#) article that the US Department of Education (ED) will release title funding for the 2025-2026 school year. While we have not yet received official confirmation, I wanted to share this with you, as it has been a challenge to approach the start of the school year without these critical funds.

For the State of Colorado, the 2024-25 allocations from last year were:

- Title 1-C: \$7,189,738
- Title II-A: \$25,937,647
- Title III-A: \$11,172,632
- Title IV-A: \$13,529,608
- Adult Education and Family Literacy (AEFLA): \$8,814,117

We have anticipated similar allocations for the coming year. As a reminder, we have not received official notice, so I cannot say that all of these funds will be released, but I am hopeful that they will be.

Federal dollars provide critical support for every child in Colorado - no matter where they live - to learn, grow, and thrive. We are grateful to US Secretary of Education Linda McMahon and to the many educators, district leaders, community partners, elected officials, and public education supporters who advocated for the release of these much-needed funds.

As soon as we receive the grant award notifications, we will review and share the updates with the field.
