

Big Themes from District Questions

- stions
- ""Which personnel costs can be charged to CRF?
- How do we calculate increased instructional hours?

Recommended path for these and any other CRF questions:

- 1) Review the allowable use guidance
- 2) Review OSC's payroll guidance
- 3) Ask yourself these two questions:
 - 1) Is this expenditure directly related to COVID-19 response?
 - 2) In absence of CRF funds, would you have had to incur this expenditure in order to operate in Fall 2020?

If yes to both, it is likely to be allowable--barring capital expenditures, which are not allowable
