**Please Note: On March 24, 2021, the US Department of Education released two-thirds of each state's ARP ESSER allocation to the states in a Grant Award Notification. Per the Department's March 24 press release, "The remainder of ARP ESSER funds will become available after states submit the plans they are developing and implementing for using ARP ESSER funds to safely reopen schools and meet the needs of students to the Department." In the ARP ESSER application, Colorado LEAs will be able to budget the full ARP ESSER (ESSER III) allocation (total award), however only two-thirds of the allocation will be available for reimbursement until CDE receives approval of the state plan for using ARP ESSER funds to safely reopen schools.
