ATTACHMENT T – Fiscal Year 2022 Condition Governing Title I, Part A Grants to Local Educational Agencies

The U.S. Department of Education (Department) placed a condition on the Colorado Department of Education's (CDE's) 2019, 2020 and 2021 Title I, Part A grant awards as a result of a letter (https://oese.ed.gov/files/2020/04/Colorado-7.pdf) from the U.S. Department of Education (the Department), dated August 27, 2019, that specified additional information needed for review and approval of the State's English language proficiency (ELP) standards and assessments under section 1111(b)(1) and (2) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA).

Subsequently, the Department sent CDE a letter, dated September 16, 2021 (https://oese.ed.gov/files/2021/09/CO-9.pdf) that specified additional information which was still needed for the review and approval of the State's ELP standards and assessment system.

The condition previously applied to the State's award for FYs 2019, 2020 and 2021 will also apply to the State's receipt of funds under this award for FY 2022 until all remaining information needed for review and approval of the State's ELP standards and assessment system under the authorities listed above has been provided. If this condition is not resolved, the Department may request additional information, revise this condition to require further action, or provide notice of its intent to take further administrative action.
