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Access is via an app available for download. Educators, including librarians, in schools with 70% or more of students in need may register to receive codes, PINs, and a letter to share with students' families. Once set up, students access the eBooks via the app on their personal or parents' smartphone or tablet or via school or library-loaned devices. The registration requires knowledge of current free/reduced lunch rates in the school.
