	Requirements

U.S. Service Member Applicants may meet content knowledge and experience requirements as follows:

- U.S. Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy or Space Force members: three or more years' active duty
- Guard/Reserves: 10 years' experience, or five years' experience with 12 months active-duty deployment
- Military Occupational Specialty (MOS), time of service and an honorable discharge must be verified on a DD-214 member copy 4 (submitted in application)

All other applicants must meet content knowledge and occupational requirements outlined below:

Content Knowledge:

- Valid FAA Ground Instructor or Part 107 Remote Pilot Certification AND
- Verification of Aviation Envoy Mentorship Program participation AND
- Certificate of completion of:
 - Wings Over the Rockies Teacher Flight Program OR
 - o The following professional development coursework:
 - FAA Fundamentals of Instruction
 - Aeronautical Knowledge
 - Drone Programs and Industry Operations

Occupational Experience:

- Six-week (240 hours) on-the-job transportation externship with an aviation partner company AND
- One year or two semesters' verified experience full-time teaching aviation-related coursework in the content area (full-time is defined as 51% or more of a teaching schedule dedicated to teaching in the content area).
