### Requirements

**Applicants must meet all requirements outlined in 1, 2 and 3:**

1. a. Hold a bachelor's degree in any agriculture or related discipline **OR**
  - b. Hold a valid Colorado teacher or alternative teacher license in any secondary (7-12) endorsement area. *(Note to alternative candidates: If you qualified for this CTE by obtaining an alternative license and do not successfully complete the alternative program and obtain an initial teacher license, this CTE authorization will be expired the date you discontinue the program.)*
2. **Content knowledge:**
  - a. 24 semester hours of related postsecondary coursework from a regionally accredited institution verified on an official transcript with a minimum of three (3) semester hours in **four** (4) of the areas listed in the table below **OR**
  - b. A passing score on the PRAXIS 5701 agriculture exam. An official score report must be submitted with the application.
3. **Experience:**

*Credit for student teaching (up to 800 hours) in the content area may be applied to either occupational or teaching experience.*

  - a. 2,000 hours of verified occupational experience in the content area **OR**
  - b. Three (3) years' verified teaching experience in the content area (full-time is defined as 51% or more of a teaching schedule dedicated to teaching in the content area).

You will be notified by CDE via email of all required coursework that is needed to advance to a professional (five-year) CTE authorization. Please do not enroll in coursework until you receive the notification from CDE.**
