- a. a valid Colorado teacher license in any secondary (7-12) content area or in a world language (K-12), a valid Colorado CTE authorization or a valid Colorado Special Services Provider license **OR**
- b. a bachelor's degree and 2,000 hours of verified occupational experience **OR**
- c. an associate's degree from a community college and 4,000 hours of verified occupational experience.
