- ☐ an approved [Multiple Measures of Content Knowledge Competencies](#) submission

B. Hold a valid Colorado teacher license with an early childhood education (ages 0-8) endorsement.

- 2. To complete a Colorado alternative program/early childhood special education and to qualify to advance to an initial teacher license (or add an ECSE endorsement to a valid Colorado teacher license), all individuals must:**

A. achieve a passing score on the following exams:

- ☐ PRAXIS #5692 / 159 **and**
- ☐ PRAXIS #5205 / 159

B. demonstrate content competency of the teaching reading and early childhood special education standards via an approved [Multiple Measures of Content Knowledge Competencies](#) submission.
