**Requirements**

**Professional competency in this content area must be demonstrated by one of the following exams:**

- A. PLACE #01** with a minimum passing score of 220.

Note: The last administration for all PLACE exams will be 5/6/2017 and passing scores will be accepted for 5 years until 5/6/2022.

**OR**

- B. Praxis #5018** (taken by 8/31/2016) with a minimum passing score of 163.

Note: Candidates who registered before 9/1/2016 for an exam administration after 8/31/2016 are able to use this exam. Passing scores will be accepted for 5 years until 8/31/2021.

**OR**

- C. Praxis #5001** is comprised of 4 sub-tests. Candidates must obtain a passing score for each-subtest. Candidates can re-take one (or more) specific sub-tests in the case of not passing one (or more) sub-tests.

Note: Effective 9/1/2016, all elementary candidates registering for a Praxis assessment must register for the 5001. The minimum passing score for each specific sub-test are:

- i. **Reading (5002):** 157
- ii. **Math (5003):** 157
- iii. **Social Studies (5004):** 155
- iv. **Science (5005):** 159

**\*Please note:** Before applying for an Initial Teacher license an applicant must also have:

- Documented evidence of completion of an approved program for the preparation of Special Education Generalists

**AND**

- **PLACE #20** (taken after 9/1/2008) with a passing score of 220

**OR**

- **Praxis #5354** with a passing score of 151.

**You must include a copy of your official score report in your application even if you requested that your scores be sent to the Colorado Department of Education.**
