

TRANSITION CONTINUUM

The intent of transition is to gradually move students from activities that are initiated early in the awareness process through the continuum of exploration and preparation and finally into career placement and/or continuing education [age 18-21]. Career placement and continuing education are the responsibility of adult service agencies. The dotted arrow designates the usual time for students to begin formal linkages with the appropriate agencies. Each student should have opportunities for career awareness, exploration, preparation and agency linkages. The activities and agencies listed are only suggestions.
