

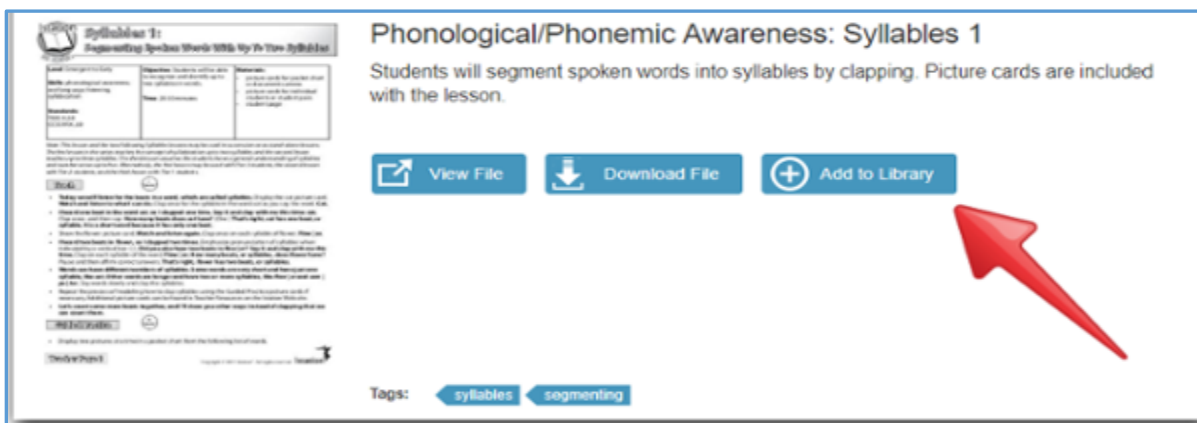

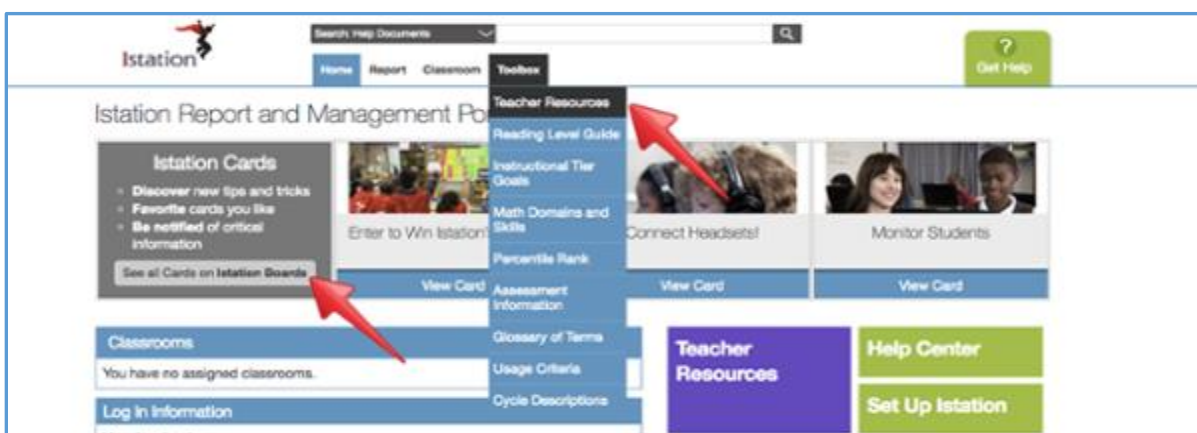
Istation's "My Library" tool lets you bookmark Istation Teacher Resources for later use by adding them to the "My Library" section of your account.

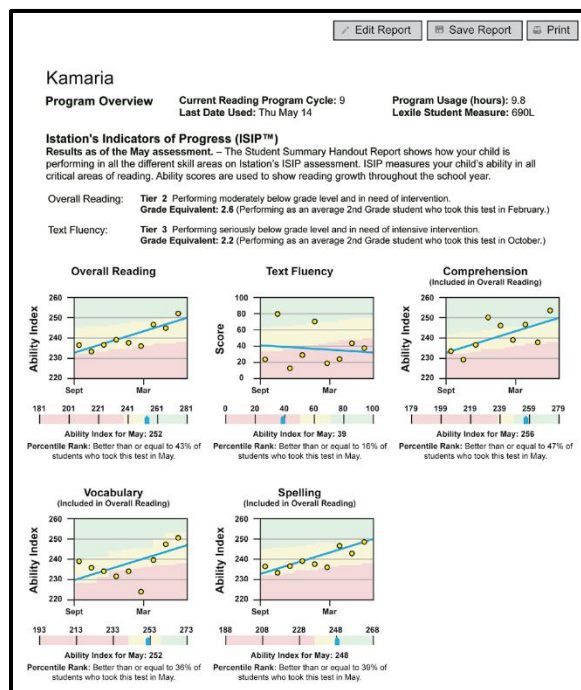
Graphic Organizer, Vocabulary Web A

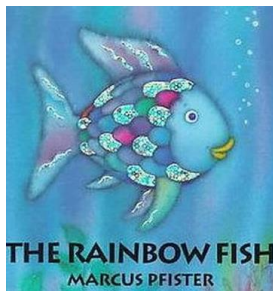

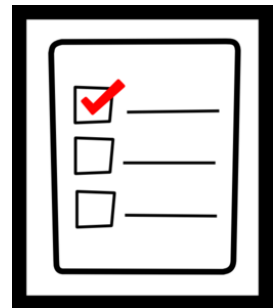

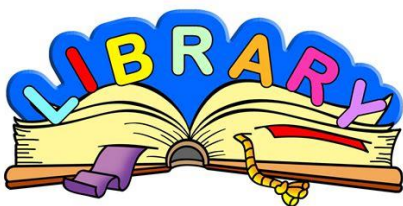
