






Let's talk about progress monitoring. How do you know what areas to monitor? Use the Hierarchy of Reading! Monitoring student progress can help teachers make informed decisions about where to go with classroom instruction. Being able to see growth over time in students' data gives teachers an idea of what's working and what to try next. Progress monitoring should occur in area of intervention on a regular basis.



Consider these reports to help identify areas in need of additional instructional support. They can provide insight for areas in need and ensure you are getting the most out of progress monitoring and instruction with your students.

Priority Report




Groups students who have shown difficulty on the assessment.

Suggested Teacher Directed Lessons are linked in PDF format for remediating that skill.

Allows for document interventions provided.

Can be used to discuss student performance with administrators or intervention team.

ISIP Summary Report



Hovering over the graph shows the number of students per tier.

Individual student results are listed in the table below the graph.

Instructional tiers are displayed for Overall Reading and for each subtest.

Identify skills that need emphasis in the classroom.


