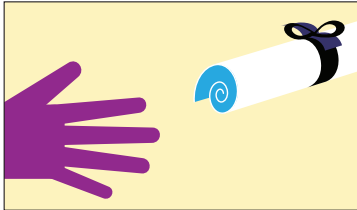


Great Learning - Measuring Student Progress through the Colorado Measures of Academic Success



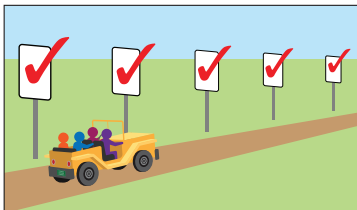
The goals for Colorado's students are to ensure that they are successful in school and once they progress to college or move into a career.

Their educational journey is framed by the **Colorado Academic Standards**, which serve as a roadmap to define the expectations for students in 10 different content areas at each grade level.

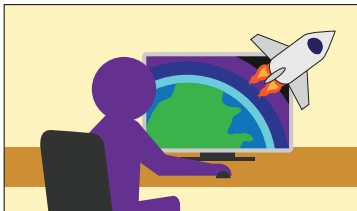


When we know what children should be learning, we can determine how well they are learning. The **Colorado Measures of Academic Success (CMAS)** are tests designed to allow students to demonstrate their understanding of the skills they need in:

- Science
- Social Studies
- Math
- English Language Arts



CMAS scores are the mile markers that provide essential data to help teachers chart new paths to help each student succeed.



The tests are **online**; they are **engaging**, involving students in **simulations**, **multi-part** problems, and **performance tasks** that reflect the importance of technology in our lives.



The tests are meant for students who show what they know and in the process, learn and deepen their knowledge.
