



## Pupil Attendance Information - Student October

### Pupil Attendance Information

Pupil Attendance Information (PAI) is used in the Student October Collection. Generally, we group PAI Codes in two sections depending on whether the student is currently attending a district program (A) or is a resident student attending an educational program not operated by the reporting district or AU (B). For the Student October Collection, there are PAI Codes of 01-08 for pupils attending an educational program operated by the reporting district (A) and codes 24-33 for resident pupils attending an educational program not operated by the reporting district (B). There are also funding code and grade level restrictions for PAI codes.

Students residing in another state or country that are attending a Colorado public school (foreign exchange students) also use 04. For students attending an online educational program run by a school district or BOCES based on a contractual agreement should be reported with a PAI of 33 by the district of residence.
05	Non-Resident, Non-Choice	Public, Valid Detention Center	N/A	N/A	N/A	Non-resident students in a non-choice placement. These students are placed by another school district or BOCES and students placed in licensed residential childcare facilities or group home.
N/A	N/A	N/A	24	Court-Mandated Juvenile Detention	Valid Detention Center Code	Non-resident students in a Detention Center are reported by the district of Residence as PAI 24. These students are detained short-term. Student committed to long-term facilities are not eligible for funding under the Public-School Finance Act. Refer to the Audit Resource Guide to determine which district claims funding as it can vary depending upon the student's attendance history.
