# Background

## Federal and State Law Governing Data Reporting Requirements

- CDE collects certain data to meet the requirements of specific federal and state laws. State Law requires student-level data for the purposes of:
  - District and school accountability
  - o Program enrollment
  - Financial allocations
  - Calculating individual student growth percentiles
- Federal Law requires aggregate data (no student-level information ) for the purposes of :
  - Schools and district performance reports for parents
  - Evaluation of specific programs
  - o Program Federal Funding, that include:
    - Special Education
    - Free/Reduced Lunch
    - English language learners (ELL)

CDE does <u>not</u> provide any collected individual student data to the federal government.

### Federal and State Student Privacy Laws

The Colorado Department of Education has student privacy procedures that fully adhere to the guidelines set forth in <u>Federal and State law</u>, but CDE includes additional safeguards such as:

- CDE's Official information security and privacy policy
- Guidance to districts for student data security and privacy policies
- Policy review and revision by national experts and advisors
- Data governance committee to determine internal accountability for student data
- Institutional Review Board to review research requests and ensure confidentiality
- Data breach notification, liability, and independent audit clauses in all vendor agreements involving individual student data
- Dedicated data privacy staff member working to enhance and expand CDE's data privacy program

## **Data Pipeline**

Data Pipeline is a data collection system used to efficiently and securely move required education information from school districts to the Colorado Department of Education. The interchanges of data are intended to be transactional in nature and are focused on:
