The Colorado Reengagement Network (CRN) will develop and disseminate statewide and national best practices, guidelines, and procedures for schools and districts to use to have a large-scale impact on reducing dropout numbers, and Colorado Youth for a Change (CYC) will be the hub to support this statewide work. This network will provide a forum for people to communicate and share information and experiences that will build insight into reengagement strategies.



The Colorado Reengagement Network

- Provides one information center (on CYC's website) as a research hub for up to date best practice in the area of student reengagement
- Provides a forum for dialogue among educational professionals where they can share ideas
- Identifies gaps in services for disengaged students or youth who have left school

- Provides a forum for disseminating information regarding currently programs available for reengagement students throughout the state
- Problem solves for tangible reengagement strategies
- Creates standards of practice for reengagement work in Colorado
- Expands participants' contacts within Colorado
