



Five-year CGER Schedule

The Colorado Department of Education (CDE) is committed to customer service that supports Administrative Units (AUs) in improving outcomes for identified gifted students through technical assistance efforts and data-based decision-making. The Colorado Gifted Education Review (CGER) is a collaborative monitoring process that is the shared responsibility of AUs and CDE. The purpose of this partnership is to increase the capacity of educators and educational systems to identify, program and be accountable for gifted learner achievement and growth.

In accordance with state statute, CGER aligns with the Rules for the Administration of Gifted Education under the Exceptional Children’s Educational Act (ECEA), Rule Section 12.07. The intent of CGER is to be a support system in fulfilling the monitoring requirements. Program evaluation is an ongoing process for AU’s with input from parents, teachers, administrators, students and community members. A CGER program evaluation is conducted by CDE every five years with input from a variety of stakeholder groups.
