Resetting and revamping 2 FT, @PT getting reestablished to move forward as a team to updates things</li> <li>Currently offering two modules for 2E and paying the other module (had to close registration due to reaching capacity)</li> <li>Heather Baskin, assistant director support 2E and monitoring data (western slope representation) statewide.</li> <li>We are working on updating Data management system, and received one-time funding to have secure system for gifted ed leads. Is in the building stage.</li> <li>3 of 4,5 modules are in developmental stages to test out.</li> <li>Finished AU submitted the budgets 60 million was spent for gifted learners across the board. No AU had contributions in their budget! Several AU had grants to support gifted. Excited to see how</li> </ul>

- personnel can be affected from the CAGT legislation Bill. Language went into the school finance Act to have consistent 5 year funding.
- Team is spending time on updating accessibility to all CDE documents, including changes on the website to make sure it is functional, grouping it by audience. 68 web pages to review. Most of the content will not be changed, just accessibility.
  - Timeline for relaunch and should we send in accessible links to CDE? (July 1st, 2024)
- Unified Improvement Plan-UIP (Annual plans state rules for gifted, required to write annual plan) directors (Building modules to add annual plans). Simplifying for the future in order to document what plans are being completed. Can we have access to State Data (state report- will be updating the data page to be easier to find for UIP comparisons. First week of January for district data changes (ready mid January) for new data.
- Rules for accessibility data changes to have all members adhere to the new changes for our personal work.
- UPK(Universal Preschool/Kindergarten)- timing is not right, but will get to it at the right time. The Director of Early childhood worked in Denver for a possible partnership.
- MATH ACT- are there any house bills that impact us as educators, community members, parents as a GCC group? Some have been removed.
  - Marcy\_ Concern about how easily the ECA rules are opened up to be edited.
