#### **Test Structure**

- Each unit is a block of testing time for students
- Math units may consist of calculator and non-calculator sections which are both completed during unit testing time

### Opening Test Packaging (plastic wrap)

Sealed packages may be opened no more than 4 days prior to testing

### **Make-up Testing**

Can test units out of order **only** for make-up testing

• Units cannot be tested out of order
