Alternative program in college environment	Approval/consultation of student admittance (final decision)
5 full time staff; 4 part time staff	Entering of enrollment paperwork

College text books	Entering of grades in Infinite Campus, making sure transcripts are current
Resource Specialist for each student	Contact and communication with GTC staff; specifically with Admin Assistant
Basic math, writing, and reading skill development	ACT administration for district students (depending on numbers, we partner on this)
College readiness skill development	Referrals through school counselors/school personnel and help setting up outreach opportunities for GTC
Onboarding of students: info sessions, testing, interviews acceptance meetings	Audit of GTC pathways to confirm diploma and graduation
