- attend five **training sessions with other** teams to learn about family engagement
- conduct and analyze a **parent survey**
- develop a targeted **family engagement plan**
- present the plan to the school staff to gain feedback and teacher ownership.
- meet monthly to prepare for upcoming academic workshops
