Overview

Supporting nurses transitioning to the specialty practice of school nursing is an important priority for the School Health Services Office at the Colorado Department of Education (CDE). This two-day School Nurse Orientation (SNO) program aims to support nurses new to school nursing by providing educational opportunities and connecting individuals to essential resources. Participants are introduced to systems, standards and general role expectations. In addition, participants will gain support through networking with peers and becoming familiar with the state resources available. There is no cost to attend SNO.
