

**SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1

RESOLUTION No. 3874**

WHEREAS, in January 2012, the Board of Education of School District No. 1 (the "District") voted to approve West Early College (formerly West Generation Academy)'s innovation plan and request for innovation designation;

WHEREAS, on March 2012, the Colorado State Board of Education voted to approve West Early College's innovation plan and request for innovation designation;

WHEREAS, on April 2015, the Board of Education of School District No. 1 (the "District") voted to extend West Early College's innovation status for a period of one years;

WHEREAS, on February 2016, the Board of Education of School District No. 1 (the "District") voted to extend West Early College's innovation status for a period of two years;

WHEREAS, from August 2017 through January 2018, West Early College reviewed and revised its innovation plan;

WHEREAS, from August 2017 through January 2018, the District's Portfolio Management Team analyzed performance data and conducted a stakeholder interview with the school leader at West Early College, and the District's Portfolio Management Team, Human Resources, and Legal teams reviewed the revised innovation plan;

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2018, the District received demonstrations of consent for continued innovation status and support for all plan changes from the teachers, administrators and community at West Early College;

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2018, District staff shared their recommendation to approve the revised innovation plan with the Board of Education;


WHEREAS, on February 15, 2018, after giving reasonable public notice, the Board of Education held public hearings in which West Early College and other interested parties could provide information regarding the revised innovation plan;

WHEREAS, following reasonable public notice, the Board of Education has considered the revised innovation plan submitted by West Early College, the comments and all additional information provided by West Early College, District staff recommendations and the District Staff Report, and the information received at public hearings.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that: The innovation status renewal for West Early College be approved for a 3-year extension, pursuant to the revised plan to which the District and West Early College mutually agree.

All of the reports and recommendations referenced above, including, but not limited to, the District

Staff Report and comments, the West Early College revised innovation plan and demonstrations of consent, are incorporated into this Resolution and made part of the official record.
