Resolution Recognizing the Contribution Bob Schaffer Has Made to the Education of Children in Colorado

- WHEREAS: Bob Schaffer has served on the State Board of Education since January 2006; and
- WHEREAS: During his term of service, he served as vice chairman in 2007 and 2008 and chairman from 2009 through January 2013;
- WHEREAS: Throughout his years of service, he along with the Board as whole, has authorized 19 innovation schools, approved numerous induction programs, reviewed and voted on 237 educator licensure disciplinary proceedings, promulgated more than 61 sets of permanent rules; certified 13 online programs, and recognized 71 of Colorado's outstanding students and educators;
- WHEREAS: He has been a strong advocate of charter schools and parental choice, and is principal of Liberty Common High School, which under his leadership, achieved the highest ACT composite score in the State of Colorado in 2012;
- WHEREAS: Mr. Schaffer, along with the Board as a whole, selected Dwight Jones as Commissioner of education in 2007;
- WHEREAS: Mr. Schaffer, along with the Board as a whole, selected Robert Hammond as Commissioner of Education in 2011;
- WHEREAS: Over the course of his service, the State of Colorado has undergone tremendous education reforms including the enactment of Colorado's Achievement Plan for Kids, the Innovation Schools Act, the Licensed Personnel Performance Evaluation Act, and the Colorado Reading to Ensure Act. He, along with the board, as a whole, supported the Department's long-term and ongoing efforts to implement Colorado's education reform agenda.


