

State discontinues mailing income tax booklets to taxpayers

Due to the continued growth of electronic income tax filing and to reduce mailing and printing costs, Colorado Department of Revenue will no longer mail income tax booklets to individual taxpayers. Please note that the department has mailed booklets only to those taxpayers who have not made the switch to electronic filing. The Department of Revenue will direct taxpayers who still want an income tax booklet to our Web site at www.TaxColorado.com We will also direct them to our state tax service center offices and Colorado Motor Vehicle offices.

Due to the decision not to mail income tax booklets, some libraries participating in our forms distribution program may see an increased demand from taxpayers requesting income tax booklets. To help with the possible increased demand and to help inform taxpayers of the changes, we will provide libraries a flier containing information on where to locate forms and how to access electronic filing options that you can give to your patrons.
