 - K-12 Standards aligned curriculum

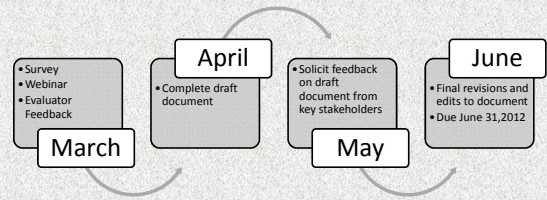
