The Denver Metro Area includes 424,781 (55.4%) of the state's total Fall 2004 student membership (766,657) in public schools. From Fall 1994 to Fall 2004 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 81,994 students (23.92%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 43,721 students (14.68%).

\* NOTE: Detention Center students were removed from the district count and pulled into a separate category. Although detention center students receive educational services from school district employees, school districts have no jurisdiction over any other detention center function.
