Vista Academy is a Denver Public School 6th-12th grade Multiple Pathway Center that is geared towards re-engaging students in the educational process. Vista Academy is the school for you if you answer yes to the following questions:

- Are you committed to obtaining an education and following the expectations that the school and teachers have established for you to obtain your Vista SWAGGER?
- Do you need teachers and staff who believe in you and provide you with supports to make sure that you are successful?
- Are you excited about the idea that you are encouraged to advocate for your learning and given the tools to make sure that you are successful?
- •Do you want to build your academic skills, and develop an individualized plan for your future so that you are able to compete with any student in the world?

If you answered yes to these questions then Vista Academy is the school for you!

Middle School Application Guidelines

- 1. Students must complete an online application or print out the application and return to Vista Academy at 4800 Telluride Street; Student Union, Building 1; Denver, CO 80249.
- 2. Students must complete a three-five minute video clip sharing who the student is for the admissions committee. The video clip can be submitted attached to the completed online application or submitted on a thumb drive or disc with a completed hard copy of the application.
- 3. Students will have to submit three recommendations; two must be from a teacher and/or school staff. The third recommendation must be from an adult not related to the applicant outside of school, which can include mentors, social worker, mental health therapist, coach, extra-curricular activity sponsor, etc....



4. All application materials must be submitted via online by midnight on December 17, 2010. If the student is submitting a hard copy of the application it must be turned in with all of the application materials to the Vista Academy Office by 4pm, December 17, 2010.

Middle School Admissions Process

The following provides the application and admissions timeline:

November 15-January 14 Applications Accepted

January 2011 Applicants are notified of acceptance to Round 2 (interviews

scheduled, and denial letters are mailed to applicants)

February 4-6 Final denial letters mailed to applicants

Final acceptance letters and invitations to Welcome Reception

mailed to applicants

February 24 Welcome Reception

Students will have the opportunity to meet each other, teachers and staff, and learn their steps on their journey to gain Vista Swagger, which includes attending Mandatory SWAGGER Enrichment on the following dates:

April 9, 2011 from 8am-12pm on the Evie Dennis Campus in the Student Union

May 14, 2011 from 8am-12pm on the Evie Dennis Campus in the Student Union

May 28, 2011 from 8am-12pm on the Evie Dennis Campus in the Student Union

Another Mandatory attendance activity is our SWAGGER Academy that will take place July 25th-29th off Campus at a location TBD. Monday, Wednesday and Friday SWAGGER Academy will be held from 9am-12pm and on Tuesday and Thursday we will go on a field trip from 9am-3pm.

The admissions process will be complete once students attend these mandatory activities. Students will enter Vista Academy under a Probationary Contract that will include attendance and academic expectations where students will have to maintain expectations to keep their admissions slot at Vista Academy.
