

### **Four Key Packets**



#### Wheel in a Wheel

- Class is numbered off as Partner 1 and Partner 2.
- Students form two circles. One circle is in the inside and facing out, and the other circle is on the outside facing the inside circle.
- The teacher presents the question for discussion.
- Partner 1 or 2 answers and then the other partner gives a response. This varies based on the task.
- After a short period of time, the teacher has the inside or outside circle rotate one spot and thereby produce new partnerships.
- The teacher provides a new question or elaborates on the existing topic.
- The procedure is repeated until the topic is finished.

### Think-Group-Share

- Students number off in groups of 3 or 4.
- The teacher poses a question to the whole class.
- The students are given time to think about the question and to write ideas about it in an informal or "quick write" fashion.
- Students each share their ideas with their individual teams.
- Team members write down any additional ideas that they like and are given by their members.
- The teacher calls one of the numbers randomly. All of the partners with that assignment share to the rest of the group or class, depending on the task.

#### Chips for Quips

- The goal of this activity is to guarantee that all students participate in an equitable fashion
- Each member of a group is given the same number of poker chips or beans.
- A student must place one chip in the middle of a table in order to have an opportunity to participate in the group discussion.
- Each student must spend all of her chips before the discussion is done.
