CareerBuilder.com to Host Teach in Colorado Job site

The Colorado Department of Education announced today TeachinColorado.org will partner with the nation's largest online job site, CareerBuilder.com to offer upgrades and major improvements.

- **Automated help function** – “Ask CareerBuilder” is available for technical help and troubleshooting 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- **Instructor-led training** is available for audiences who benefit from a more traditional classroom environment.
- **Customized search function** can search by job title and location, and also by keyword.
