Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board Announces Next Meeting and Upcoming Rulemaking Hearings

The next meeting of the Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board is scheduled for Monday, Oct. 6 in Denver.

The meeting will be held from 9 a.m. to noon in the Governor's Energy Office, 1580 Logan St. in Denver.

Rulemaking Hearings

The board also announced two upcoming rulemaking hearings. The first, to decide permanent rules for the Full-Day Kindergarten Facility Capital Construction Assistance Program is scheduled for Monday, Nov. 3, 2008 at 10 a.m. A hearing for the Public School Facility Guidelines will follow at 10:30 a.m. Both hearings will be held at the Colorado Department of Education, 201 E. Colfax Ave. in the first floor board room.

"Gov. Ritter requested the freeze and Commissioner of Education, Dwight D. Jones supports the request to delay grants to expand fullday kindergarten facilities," said Ted Hughes, director of division of public school capital construction assistance. "That doesn't stop us from moving forward with preparing the rules and being ready to go the minute the funds are released."

Written and oral data, comments and arguments will be received and must be filed at or before the start of the hearings on Nov. 3, 2008 in order to be considered.
