The Colorado Department of Education today announced the publication of a new Web page that provides a wide variety of school and district information.

School districts are sorted alphabetically, with links to schools within each district.

The pages include contact information (including local school district Web links), assessment data and results including both Colorado Student Assessment Program and Colorado Growth Model data, Adequate Yearly Progress results, post-secondary readiness data including graduation rates and information about highly qualified teachers and teacher experience.

Data may be viewed for the district as a whole or for each school. The Web page also includes the 21 BOCES (Boards of Cooperative Educational Services) that provide a variety of educational services to multiple districts in various regions of the state.

Commissioner Dwight D. Jones said the school and district profile Web page will continue to evolve. "We believe parents, educators and community members deserve a convenient, one-stop-shop to access school and district data," said Commissioner Jones. "The department

will continue to explore and improve these pages so the data are relevant, easy to explore and always up to date."
