Four Colorado State Board of Education Members Swear In on Jan. 13

The Colorado State Board of Education announced today it will hold a swearing in ceremony for newly elected members Angelika Schroeder and Marcia Neal and incumbent and recently elected members Elaine Gantz Berman and Jane Goff.

The swearing in will take place on Tuesday, Jan. 13 in the lobby of the Colorado Department of Education, 201 E. Colfax Ave. in Denver, from 3 to 5 p.m.

Angelika Schroeder, who was chosen by a vacancy committee of the Democratic Party, will represent the 2nd Congressional District. She replaces former board member Evie Hudak, who was elected to the Colorado Senate.

A retired teacher, Marcia Neal won her bid to represent the 3rd Congressional District after board chair Pamela Jo Suckla chose not to run for re-election.

Board member Elaine Gantz Berman, who ran unopposed to represent the 1st Congressional District, and Jane Goff, who was elected to represent the 7th Congressional District, both begin full six-year terms this month. Both Berman and Goff were previously appointed to fill vacancies on the board.
