***CANCELLED: CAP4K Town Hall Meeting in Limon Thursday,
March 26 on Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness***

Due to the weather forecast, the Colorado Department of Education, Colorado Department of Higher Education and Lincoln County Economic Development Corporation have cancelled a town hall meeting originally set for 5–7 p.m. Thursday, March 26 at the Limon Community Building, 477 D Ave., Limon.

The meeting — one of 12 statewide planned to solicit a broad spectrum of community thinking — will be rescheduled.

The work was launched by Senate Bill 08-212, the “Preschool to Postsecondary Education Alignment Act” also known as the Colorado Achievement Plan for Kids (CAP4K).

Similar community meetings are scheduled from 5–7 p.m. Wednesday, April 15 in Alamosa; Thursday, April 16 in Pueblo; Wednesday, April 22, in Sterling; Tuesday, May 5 in Steamboat Springs; Thursday, May 14, in Glenwood Springs; and Tuesday, May 19, in Durango. Precise locations will be announced.
