CANCELLED: CAP4K Town Hall Meeting in Limon Thursday, March 26 on Postsecondary and Workforce Readiness

Due to the weather forecast, the Colorado Department of Education, Colorado Department of Higher Education and Lincoln County Economic Development Corporation have cancelled a town hall meeting originally set for 5–7 p.m. Thursday, March 26 at the Limon Community Building, 477 D Ave., Limon.

The meeting — one of 12 statewide planned to solicit a broad spectrum of community thinking — will be rescheduled.

The work was launched by Senate Bill 08-212, the "Preschool to Postsecondary Education Alignment Act" also known as the Colorado Achievement Plan for Kids (CAP4K).
