Cancelled: Facility Schools Board Meeting on Friday, April 3

The Facility Schools Board has cancelled its meeting originally set for 8 a.m.—2 p.m. Friday, April 3 in Lakewood.

The next meeting will be held Friday, May 1. Additional upcoming meeting dates are June 5, July 10, Aug. 7, Sept. 4, Oct. 2, Nov. 6 and Dec. 4.

About the Facility Schools Board

House Bill 08-1204, the Facility Schools Bill, establishes a board that consists of seven members appointed by the Colorado State Board of Education. The Facility Schools Board will work to improve the educational outcomes of students placed in residential, day treatment and hospital programs.

The board will adopt curriculum standards and set graduation requirements for facility schools. It is also charged with adopting accountability measures, including academic performance measures and awarding high school diplomas to students in approved facility schools who meet the graduation requirements.

In addition, the legislation requires the implementation of a statewide student data system to maintain grades and transcripts of students in facilities. A new office was created within CDE to perform administrative responsibilities related to facility schools.
