Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board Announces Rulemaking Hearing for Oct. 7

The Public School Capital Construction Assistance Board (CCAB) will hold a rulemaking hearing on Wednesday, Oct. 7 beginning at 10 a.m. at 5240 Geiger Blvd. in Colorado Springs.

The subjects of the proposed rulemaking hearing include:

- Promulgating revisions to the permanent rules on the subject of the Building Excellent Schools Today Grant Program;
- Promulgating revisions to the permanent rules on the Public School Facility Guidelines;
- Promulgating revisions to the permanent rules on the subject of the Full-Day Kindergarten Facility Capital Construction Assistance.

Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained on or before Friday, Oct. 2 from the Division of Capital Construction Assistance, 1525 Sherman St., Room B17, Denver, CO 80203.
