As requested by the Colorado Department of Education, MGT of America, Inc. (MGT) updated its report entitled *Results of the Financial and Organizational Review of the Cesar Chavez School Network* issued on May 3, 2010. MGT has reissued the report to make two minor corrections to the text and update two tables in the original report. MGT notes that the corrections have not resulted in changes to our findings or recommendations, but revised it in the interest of ensuring that the public has access to accurate information.

The first text change was made on page 2 to update the number of findings and recommendations referenced within the executive summary. The second text change is on page 18 to change the word "brother-in-law" to "stepbrother."

In the table presented on page 69 of our report "CCA Building Corporation Vendors", the team has made corrections to the totals. In creating the original table, the majority of differences occurred because the team had included expenditures that the schools capitalized as depreciable assets, and which should not have been included in the total payments information.

In the table presented in Appendix C of our report showing the number of meetings held and determination of a quorum, the team has made corrections to the quorum determination and attendance total columns. In updating the table with additional minutes provided by the Cesar Chavez School Network late in the process, the quorum and attendance columns should have been updated to accurately reflect the numbers presented within the body of the report on page 27.
