Ten-City Public Feedback Tour Launches Next Week In Lakewood; Continues Final Phase Of State Assessment System Revision

The Colorado Department of Education and the Colorado Department of Higher Education will jointly host a public feedback tour to learn about the draft recommendations for Colorado's new assessment system. The tour will allow the public to provide feedback to the departments before final recommendations move to the Colorado State Board of Education and Commission on Higher Education.
